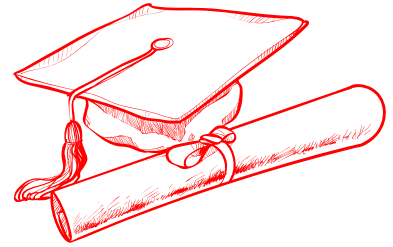


Where is she now?
